The celebration highlights the importance of bringing together educators, parents, students, and communities in a unified effort to build great public schools. It also reflects NEA's vision of calling upon America to provide public school students with quality schools so that they can grow and achieve in the 21st century.

During the week of November 14th-18th, our school will be open to parents and grandparents that would like to observe what a typical day looks like for students at Worthington. We would like to share with you a snapshot into your child's daily routine. We invite you to join us anytime between 9:45 am - 3:00 pm throughout the week. Arriving and leaving at these times helps to ensure a smooth arrival and dismissal for all of our buses and many cars. We are hoping with a flexible, open schedule, you will be able to find a time that is convenient during your day to visit. As you know, parking can be problematic and spreading your visits throughout the week should lessen the crowded parking lot.

During your visit, you will see children in action. Teachers will not be creating special activities or events but will continue with their daily instruction. During this visit, younger siblings are not permitted to attend. This is a special time to see your elementary student shine.

A few last reminders: This is an educational time for your child. Our daily instruction will continue while you visit. Therefore, please limit any interaction you may have with your child and understand that teachers will not be able to hold personal conversations with you at this time. We also ask that you keep your cell phones off (put on silence or vibrate) out of respect for the classroom environment. In addition, please refrain from taking photographs. All visitors will still be required to sign in at the Lobby Gurad kiosk in the front office. You will need your driver's license to sign in with Lobby Guard. All visitors and volunteers are required to complete the following documentation prior to volunteering: <u>Confidentiality Training Course</u> and <u>Child Abuse</u> <u>Training course</u>. Visitors should print out the certificates associated with these trainings (below) and hand them in to the Front Office. <u>Confidentiality Training</u> <u>Certificate</u> and <u>Child Abuse Training Certificate</u>.

Hints from the Health Room

- **Please keep all sick children at home.** Any student with a temperature of 100 should be kept at home for 24 hours past the last fever (without medications).
- Encourage your child to wash their hands frequently to reduce the spread of germs.
- Stay home while sick and limit contact with others.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with your sleeve or tissue.
- Wash hands frequently and thoroughly with soap & warm water.
- Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer if washing is not available.
- Avoid touching your nose, eyes, and mouth.
