INSIDER INFORMATION

SEL Day is a global, grassroots campaign for social-emotional learning to support children's mental health and well-being. At WOES, SEL is an essential part of our daily practices to build community, foster belonging, and amplify student voice. All week we're celebrating the work that our students have been doing to grow their brain, handle big feelings, be kind and have empathy for each other, and solve problems. On Friday we will celebrate with a Positive Messages Spirit Day! Everyone is encouraged to wear something with a positive message and / or share positive messages with others at school and at home.

Here are some core examples of SEL skills that are students are building every day:

SEL Skills

- Self-Awareness—My recognition of who I am, what I need and how I feel relative to the world around me.
- Self-Management—My ability to manage my emotions and behaviors, to complete a task or succeed in a challenging situation.
- Social Awareness—My demonstration of consideration for others and a desire to positively contribute to my community.
- Relationship Skills—My ability to use positive communication and social skills to interact effectively with others.
- Decision Making—My approach to problem solving that involves learning from others, past experiences and my values to guide my action and accepting responsibility for my decisions.

Kindergarten Registration

Kindergarten Registration for the 2024–2025 school year begins Monday, March 4. Children must be 5 years old by September I, 2024 to enroll in kindergarten. Every eligible child must be enrolled in a kindergarten program this fall or have an approved waiver form. Please note, 2024–2025 kindergarten waivers will be posted by March I. RECC Registration

The Worthington Regional Early Childhood Center (RECC) prekindergarten programs are making preparations for classes for the upcoming 2024–2025 school year. These classes include children with and without disabilities. The program's focus is helping all children develop communication, literacy, math, problem solving, motor, and social skills. Parents of children who will be 3 or 4 by September 1st, applications will be available and accepted in mid February.

In alignment with <u>Maryland's Blueprint for the Future</u>, a limited number of new applications for students turning 4 by September I will be available. The Howard County Public School System continues to offer a prekindergarten program for income eligible children who will be four years old by September I. HCPSS is committed to providing instruction based on the statewide Early Learning Standards which are in alignment with Kindergarten Readiness. The fees listed in the application will be collected monthly regardless of the learning model determined by HCPSS throughout the upcoming school year (virtual, hybrid, in person, or class quarantine).
