Dear Worthington Community,

Tonight, a number of Worthington teams will be competing in the Howard County Library's Battle of the Books or BOB for short. This will occur this evening at the Merriweather Post Pavilion. We wish them well as they compete against other Howard County schools.

Reminders as we progress to the end of the school year ;

Any parent wishing staff to consider retention or acceleration for their child should contact their child's teacher to discuss the possibility. This should be done by Friday April 26th. **This is the final reminder.** 

In May, the staff will begin the articulation process and placing children in classes for next year. The process is on-going and will continue throughout the summer. Staff primarily group students based on reading and mathematics needs. We also look at the make-up of the class. Of course, another guiding factor will be the special needs of our students. We welcome communication from parents who want to make sure we have certain information about your child. This information should be shared with the principal by a written letter or an email sent to the principal. If sending a hand-written letter, please include your email address for confirmation of receipt. While we will make every effort to address your concerns, there are no guarantees of specific requests. Often, we are limited by the number of staff assigned to each grade level. Our plans at the moment are to make class assignments available to parents on Weds. August 21st by 4:00 pm. **The deadline to send this communication to the principal is Weds. May 15, 2024**.
